

JUNIOR MARKET SWINE

IMPORTANT INFORMATION

Please review the following information regarding the 2011 NWSS Junior Market Swine show. This process consists of an application followed by a drawing. If you are successful in the drawing then you may buy your animal and make entries.

- To be eligible to exhibit at the National Western Stock Show, the youth must be **nine (9) years of age** but not **nineteen (19) years of age** as of January 1, 2011, and formally enrolled and is a member in good standing in 4-H or FFA. You must also comply with the National Western Stock Show Rules and Regulations and Junior Livestock Show Rules and Regulations that are in the Premium Book or on the web site at www.nationalwestern.com.
- Applications for the drawing must be submitted to the National Western Stock Show Livestock Office along with a non-refundable \$5.00 per animal charge. The application must be postmarked on or before August 1, 2010. No postage meters will be accepted.
- Participants may submit application for up to four swine for the draw. If you are successful in the draw, you may enter four (4) and show two (2) of the animals that were entered. **REMINDER: YOU MAY ONLY ENTER THE NUMBER YOU APPLY FOR IN THE DRAW!**
- Only one (1) application per individual. If you get drawn for the 2011 National Western but are not able to enter, we need in writing a valid excuse telling us the reason why by November 1, 2010 to the livestock office. If no letter is submitted you will not be eligible for the draw the following year.
- The National Western will conduct a random drawing before the end of August and notification of results will be sent. No notification will be made by E-mail, internet or telephone. Those that are successful in the drawing will be sent an entry form and DNA kits which must be returned, along with the entry fee of \$25.00 per animal entered, by November 1, 2010. **DNA Kits: The National Western Stock Show will be accepting HAIR DNA samples on the pigs.**
- We will draw for 700 animals.
- **All Junior Market Swine that make the sale will be drug tested. Please review all rule changes.**
- **REMINDER: This is a Terminal Show.**

PUREBRED CLASS INFORMATION

To be eligible to exhibit in purebred classes of the Junior Market Swine Show, exhibitors must be members of the National Junior Swine Association or Team Purebred Junior Association. (For membership information, contact the NJSA @ 765-463-3594 or Team Purebred Junior Association, 765-497-3618). Show animals are required to be owned by and must be exhibited by the youth in whose name the entry is made, except in the case of more than one entry per class. **Registration papers must have been transferred to or registered in the name of the exhibitor by December 1, 2010.**

All purebred entries must be ear-notched, with notches matching the registration papers. All swine entered in special breed classes will be checked at processing by NSR/NJSA and Team Purebred personnel.

Special breed classes will be provided for registered Duroc, Hampshire, Landrace, Poland China, Spotted, Yorkshire, Berkshire, and Chester White market hogs. No minimum number requirement for Purebred classes.

All purebred entries are to be guaranteed negative of the stress gene.

NSR, NJSA, Team Purebred, and the National Western Stock Show reserve the right to randomly collect a DNA profile on exhibited purebred entries for stress gene, parentage identification, and breed purity.

All breed champions, reserve champions and/or any randomly selected market swine may be blood tested for presence of the stress gene, parentage verification and breed purity as DNA technology becomes available.

Any market hogs that fail these DNA tests for the stress gene, parentage verification or breed purity will forfeit all show premiums and awards. Market Swine must meet all registration eligibility requirements of their respective breed associations. NSR field staff or qualified NSR representative will inspect all market swine for breed eligibility.
